Selection Criteria

- **East Baton Rouge Parish Residents**
- First Come, First Serve
- One Youth per Household
- Ages 16-24
- Must meet (1) or more of the following barriers:
 - Youth not attending any school
 - Not younger than 16 or older than 24.
 - > A school dropout
 - A youth who is within the age of compulsory school attendance, but has not attended school for at least the most recent complete school year calendar quarter.
 - A recipient of a secondary school diploma or equivalency who is a low-income individual and is either basic skills deficient or an English language learner.
 - An offender
 - ➤ A homeless individual, a homeless child or youth, or a runaway.
 - An individual who is pregnant or parenting.
 - An individual with a disability.
 - A low income individual who requires additional assistance to enter or complete an educational program or to secure or hold employment.
 - An individual in foster care or who has aged out of the foster care system or who has attained 16 years of age and left foster care for kinship guardianship or adoption, a child eligible for
